





# Waziri Chana ashauri mbinu kukwepa migogoro kimkataba

WAZIRI wa Sheria na Katiba, Pindi Chana, amezitaka serikali za mitaa na hal-mashauri kupata ushauri wa kisheria kutoka ofisi ya wakili mkuu wa serikali kabla ya kuingia mikataba, ili kuinusuru serikali kuingia hasara ya kulipa mamilioni ya fedha na migogoro.

Chana alitoa rai hiyo jana jijini Dar es Salaam wakati akizungumza na wafanyakazi wa Ofisi ya Wakili Mkuu wa Serikali alipokwenda kuwatembelea baada ya kuteuliwa na Rais Samia Suluhu Hassan kushika wadhifa huo.

Alisema taasisi za serikali, ofisi za serikali za mitaa na hal-mashauri nchini, zinatakiwa kuitumia ofisi hiyo kabla na wakati wa kuingia mikataba, kwa kuwa kufanya hivyo, pia kutasaidia kuepuka migogoro ambayo imekuwa ikiibuka mara kwa mara na kuisababishia hasara ya mamilioni ya fedha.

"Tunapotetea serikali zile fedha zinassida kuleta maendeleo na kujenga miundombinu... Wizara ya Sheria na Katiba inaacha milango wazi kwa wananchi kupata ushauri kwenye masuala ya mirathi na madai," alisema na kusisitiza kuwa: Masuala ya haki, utawala bora ndiyo msingi wa uongozi, unapokuwa na jambo lako tuambiane na serikali, vinginevyo uko mbele utakwama".

Pamoja na mambo mengine, alipongeza ofisi hiyo kwa kuitetea serikali ndani na nje ya nchi na kuokoa mamilioni ya fedha ambazo zingelipwa kama iliyoshtakiwa. "Mmelinda nchi, haki, immeitetea serikali ndani na nje ya nchi hongereni kwa kuokoa fedha nyinji am-

bazo zitatumika kujenga miundombinu na kutekeleza miradi ya maendeleo."

Vilevile, aliishauri ofisi hiyo kujenga jengo lake jirani na Mahakama Kuu Dodoma na mikoa mingine nchini, ili huduma zake ziwafikie wananchi kwa urahisi zaidi.

Awali, Wakili Mkuu, Boniface Luhende, alisema ofisi hiyo ilianzishwa ili kui-marisha uwezo wa serikali kuendesha mashauri na madai yanayofunguliwa dhidi yake.

Lubeje alitataja baadhi ya kesi ambazo ofisi yake imefanikiwa kuzimaliza na kuinusuru serikali kulipa mamilioni ya fedha kuwa ni ya ujenzi wa SGR iliyofunguliwa nchini Rwanda.

Nyingine ni ya madini iliyofunguliwa jijini London nchini Uingereza ambayo ilimalizika kwa njia ya usuluhishi baada ya kuondolewa mahakamani. Kwa mujibu wa Wakili Mkuu huyo, Serikali ilitakiwa kulipa dola bilioni 3 ambazo ni sawa na Shilingi trilioni saba.

"Dola bilioni tatu sawa na Shilingi trilioni saba tumeokoa, London tumeendsha wenye, tungetumia kampuni tungelipa fedha nyingi mno," alisema.

Alitaja baadhi ya changamoto wanazokumbana nazo kuwa ni taasisi za umma kutohakana na kutozingatia mwongozo na kusababisha mgogoro.

Vilevile, alisema kuna taasisi za serikali zimekuwa zikivunja mikataba bila kushirikisha ofisi yake na kusababisha miradi ya ujenzi kukwama.

Alisema taasisi hizo pia zimekuwa zichelewesha malino na kusababisha serikali kushtakiw na kuingia katika migogoro.

Rais Mwinyi alizungumzia ushirikiano mzuri uliopo baina ya Taasisi ya Kupambana na Kuzuia Rushwa ya Zanzibar (ZAICA) na ya kupambana na dawa za kulevyo, zimepata msada wa kujengewa uwezo na wenzao kutoka Bara kwa kupewa mafunzo.

"Bila shaka ni sahihi kabisa lazima kuwe na kubadilishana ujuzi na uzoefu, ushirikiano wa karibu," alisema.

## Public institutions told to consult OSG before making legal decisions

ALL public institutions have been tasked to consult the Office of Solicitor General (OSG) before making any legal decisions to avoid the government's inevitable losses.

Ambassador Dr Hindi Chana, Minister for Constitutional and Legal Affairs, made the call yesterday in Dar es Salaam when she paid a courtesy call at the OSG office as part of her routine visits of all the offices under the ministry.

Dr Chana said that there have been many losses arising from the government paying compensation to companies and individuals in claims that the government was basically entitled to.

"Time has come for our institutions, local governments to work with the guidance of OSG, particularly in litigation related issues, so they can receive the Solicitor General advice on the best course of action before the issues are addressed," she said.

She however requested that OSG be prepared to welcome all government institutions and provide them with the necessary directions so that they can follow the process when they require help to close potential legal dispute loopholes.

"Therefore, as government lawyers, I advise you to be ready at all times to receive questions, opinions, and guidelines regarding the proper procedure so that our institutions can work professionally," she emphasized.

According to her, by doing so, the government will somehow prevent losing funds that would have been used for a number of development projects.

Dr Chana also applauded the OSG for educating individuals and public institutions on the numerous steps that may be taken to defend both individual rights and the overall interests of the government.

She also commended OSG for resolving a large number of claims and proceedings in a very short period of time opened against the government in various parts of the country and abroad and being able to save billions of dollars that would be used as compensation.

Dr Boniface Lubende, Solicitor General encouraged the government to increase the office's budget in order for it to operate more effectively while also applauding the effectiveness of his office in settling several legal disputes quickly.

"Therefore, as government lawyers, I advise you to be ready at all times to receive questions, opinions and guidelines regarding the proper procedure so that our institutions can work professionally," she emphasised.

According to her by doing so, the government will avoid losing funds that would have been used for execution of a number of development proj-

ects.

The OSG was re-established in 2018 to enhance and strengthen government's ability to litigate civil cases, including human rights and constitutional matters, in courts of law and undertake arbitral proceedings in tribunals.

It was also re-established to enhance effective supervision of civil cases in courts of law, including human rights and constitutional matters and carry out the general coordination of the conduct of civil litigation and arbitral proceedings on behalf of the Central Government.
